Andrews Elementary Educators use movies or video clips throughout the year to help reinforce standards being taught in the classroom. State Standards and National Technology Standards require educators to give students the opportunity to learn through various types of media. Examples of various types of media included but are not limited to DVD and online movies, documentaries, video clips via educational websites, digitally recorded clips, online periodicals with videos, online educational games with videos. The GCSD policy states that educators can allow students to view G rated movies and online videos for educational purposes without parent permission as long as the school administration approves a request for classroom.

This parent/guardian permission form is a general form allowing students to view PG movies and PG online videos that have been approved by administration. All movies and videos will be viewed for appropriateness by teachers before students are allowed to view the media.
