Ten steps to success:

- 1) Use weekly grade sheets to monitor status of current grade.
- 2) Use all class time for current work, missing work and continuing to update all tests.
- 3) Assignment-sheets detailing daily work for the entire week are given out at the beginning of each week. Complete all daily assignments to prepare for weekly assessments.
- 4) When not attending class for any and all reasons, use assignment-sheets to stay current and prepare for the weekly test. Because weekly test are cumulative, they can be used to excuse some zeros from missed assignments (excused absences only).
- 5) Complete all problems on the practice test to prepare for weekly assessments.
- 6) Update all previous assignments and previous assessments to prepare for current weekly assessment.
- 7) Take notes. All notes may be used on every weekly assessment.
- 8) Use a 3-ringed notebook to organize notes and all papers. All notes may be used on every weekly assessment.
- 9) Use a tutor. Check the list in the Guidance Office, Media Center or classroom.
- 10) Additional help is available by appointment if class time has been used as described above.


