## College Scholarship Information:

A \$500.00 scholarship is to be awarded when the treasury exceeds \$1000.00 and there is a qualified applicant. The scholarship will follow these guidelines:

- 1. In January, the chapter will send the information to the four area high school guidance councilors (and education departments of select colleges.)
  - a. The applicant must major in education.
  - b. The applicant must be a resident of Georgetown County or attends/attended a Georgetown County School.
  - c. The scholarship is not limited to high school seniors.
  - d. The applicant will furnish two letters of recommendation written by any person able to represent the student's needs such as an educational professional, a member of the clergy, or community leader.
  - e. The student completes the application packet, including the Statement of Intent, and turns it in on time.
  - f. Each application packet is to be received on or before March 31.
  - g. The scholarship committee will review all of the above and select the candidate.1) In the event of a stalemate, members' children will be given 1st priority. In the event of multiple applications from members' children, GPA will determine the
    - recipient.
    - 2) GPA will be the deciding factor if two (2) candidates are "tied".
    - 3) Extracurricular activities will be used to break a tie beyond GPA.
  - 2. The scholarship will be presented at the awards ceremony of the recipient's high school and articles will be submitted to the local newspapers. College students will be notified by mail.
  - 3. Students may/should re-apply each year.
