

# **REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS**

**IMPORTANT:** Students who are interested in playing college sports and being recruited by college coaches must register with the NCAA clearinghouse.

Students must graduate from High School and have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.00 in a core curriculum of 16 academic subjects for Division I and 14 for Division II (students enrolling on or after August 1, 2013 in a Division II college must complete 16 core courses).

It is recommended that student athletes should register with the NCAA Clearinghouse no later than the end of their junior year in high school. Although there is no actual registration deadline, but you must be cleared by the Clearinghouse before you can receive a scholarship or compete in your sport.

## 5. Continue to fill out your information until you have created your profile



There is a one-time \$65.00 processing fee. Students who used a fee waiver to register for the SAT or ACT may request a waiver for the NCAA processing fee. Students requesting the waiver must notify their counselor upon completing the NCAA registration so that the counselor can waive the fee. NCAA registration will not be considered complete until either the \$65.00 has been paid or the fee has been waived by a counselor. There is a 30 day time limit from the time you register until the fee is paid or the registration will be cancelled.
