Required Materials:

Students should have all materials every day to be fully prepared for class and receive rehearsal credit. Not having proper materials everyday will result in grade reductions.

Grading Policy

All students will be required to bring instruments to band class EVERY DAY. In order to be successful on an instrument, students must practice daily for at least 20 to 30 minutes during after-school hours. Students will keep a daily practice log/chart, and parents will sign each day. Practice Logs are due on the last day of the chart. This necessary form will account for 10% of a student's grade. Students that do not practice but turn in a signed chart anyway, will struggle to reach their playing potential, so it is extremely important to put in the time at home!
