<p style="text-align: center;">STORY ELEMENT CEREAL BOX</p> <p>Design a cereal box that reflects the story elements (character, setting, problem, solution) with the novel.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">WHERE IN THE BOOK</p> <p>Draw a map to the place your character traveled. Be sure to label and explain where each of the important events took place.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">NOVEL PLAYLIST</p> <p>Produce a playlist of at least 5 musical selections that reflect any of the following and briefly explain why you choose the song and how it connects to your novel:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Theme • Main idea • Author’s purpose/perspective • Character’s Life 	<p style="text-align: center;">INSIDE/OUT CHARACTER STUDY</p> <p>Identify and discuss the external and internal attributes in a character that you have chosen. Discuss how these attributes affect the decisions that the character makes throughout the novel.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">LOOK IT UP</p> <p>Create a 20(+) word dictionary that reflects words, new or interesting, to you. Provide the page number and sentence found in your book. In addition, the meaning, part of speech, and your own drawing/image representation of the word.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">FAKEBOOK PAGE</p> <p>Create a Facebook page for the main character. Include the groups the character would join, provide three status updates, identify 5 people the character would choose as friends and justify your choices for the characters with a brief explanation.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">AROUND THE BOOK</p> <p>Design a travel brochure that reflects the setting in your or novel. Be sure to include details about the setting.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">CALLING ALL TALK HOSTS</p> <p>Type a one to two page fictitious interview with the author or a major character from the book which reveals and extends important information in the book. Provide full, rich, and complete responses</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PLOT SUMMARY</p> <p>Write a detailed (minimum one page) plot summary of the novel.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">CHANGE THE ENDING</p> <p>Write a (minimum one page) different ending to your novel.</p>

Write a brief description/explanation of the page.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">*PLOT DIAGRAM</p> <p>Create a plot diagram that depicts the exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution. Identify theme(s), major conflict(s), title, and author.</p>
