Students in Kindergarten and first grade have a set number of books to read each nine weeks, as determined by their classroom teacher. Each student who meets his/her goal each nine weeks will be recognized on the morning show and at Success Day by receiving pencils and bookmarks. Students who meet their reading goal at least three of the four nine weeks will be invited to our end of the year celebration, complete with prizes and of course... cookies!

Ask any second, third, fourth or fifth grader at McDonald Elementary and they'll tell you, "I read and 'Ice Cream' for Books!" At the beginning of each nine weeks, students take a computerized test to determine their present reading levels. Each student's individual reading goal for the nine week period is determined by their level and the amount of daily reading minutes. Students then select books, based upon their levels, to read and complete AR tests. Students who reach their individual reading goals each nine weeks are recognized on the morning show and at Success Day by receiving pencils and bookmarks. Students who meet their reading goal at least three of the four nine weeks will be invited to our end of the year celebration, complete with prizes and ICE CREAM!
