Jump Rope For Heart

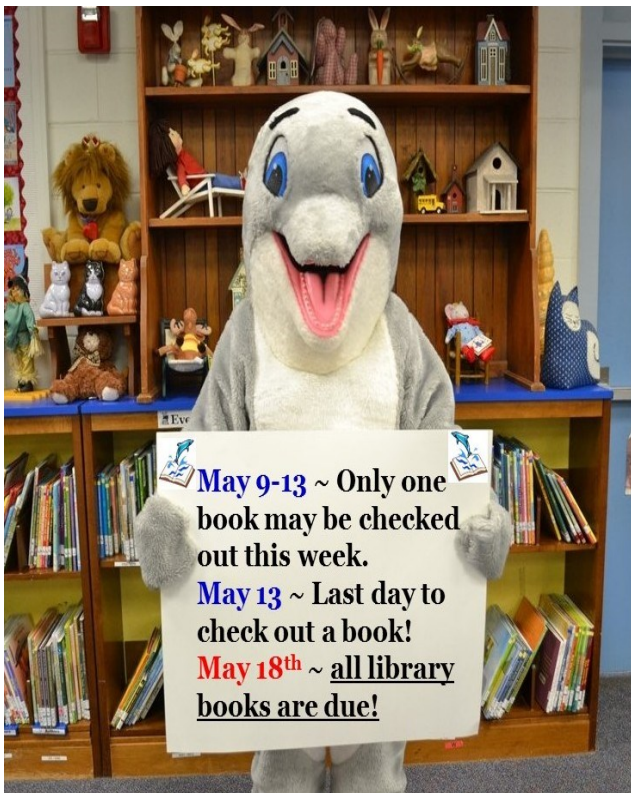

2015-2016 yearbooks will be available for purchase on Wednesday, May 18, 2016 on a first come first serve basis.

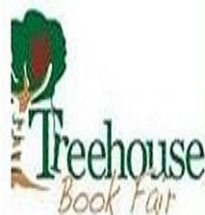

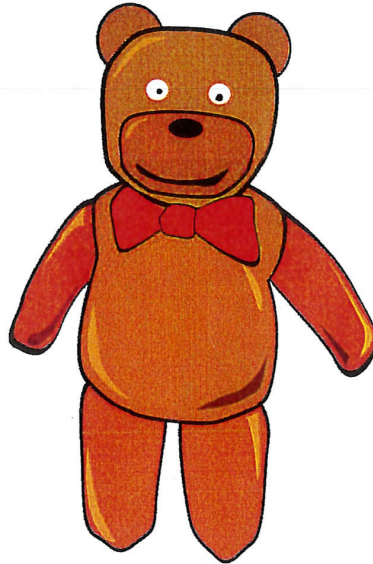
