Monday: Skip into Reading by Wearing Stripes!

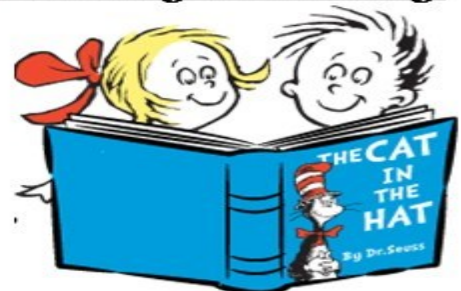

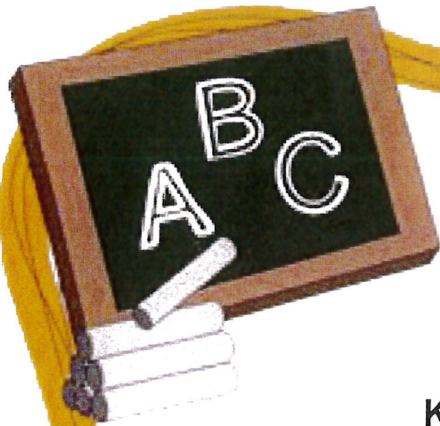

Pre-Kindergarten (Child Development) and Kindergarten Registration



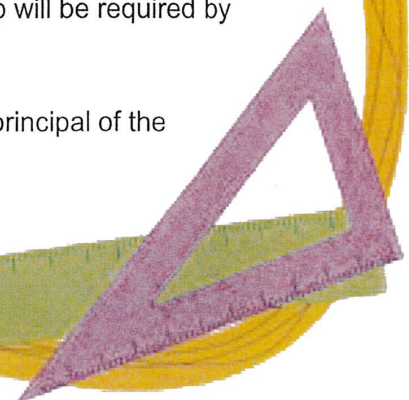
Registration for children entering the pre-kindergarten (child development) program for four-year-olds or the kindergarten program for five-year-olds in Georgetown County School District will be held Wednesday, March 2nd from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and on Thursday, March 3rd from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at each public elementary school in the county.

Georgetown County Schools offer a program for four-year-old children at each public elementary school. A child must be four years old on or before September 1, 2016 to register for the pre-kindergarten program. Registering a child does not guarantee acceptance into the program as children must be tested to determine if they are eligible.

All children five years old on or before September 1, 2016 are required to register and attend kindergarten unless parents sign a waiver accepting responsibility for their child not being in public school. This waiver is available at the school. Full-day kindergarten is available at all public elementary schools in Georgetown County.

Parents should bring their child's legal birth certificate and current South Carolina Certificate of Immunization (shot record) when registering their child. Proof of residency and/or legal guardianship will be required by the school administration.

For more information, parents may contact the principal of the elementary school in their child's attendance area.
