Coach Lawson and four students, Alexandra Jaouiche, Sara Ness, Jake Homan, and Sam Averette, traveled to the George Mason University Speech and Debate tournament in Fairfax,

Virginia, over the weekend of December  $2^{nd}$ - $5^{th}$ . Averette and Ness both attended Speech Camp at GMU over the summer (Averette for the past three summers). The GMU tournament gives students the chance to try competing against the rest of the nation – 31 states were present, and over 3300 competitors.

Averette was a Quarter Finalist in Original Oration, and a Finalist in Humorous Interpretation, receiving a final placing of fifth. Averette's placements earned him qualifying legs in each event to the National Individual Event Tournament of Champions (NIETOC) to be held in Kansas in May. This was Averette's first qualifying leg in Humorous Interpretation, but is his final qualifying leg in Original Oration. Congratulations to Averette for qualifying to the NIETOC!
