THE COOLIDGE A SCHOLARSHIP FOR AMERICA

The Coolidge Scholarship is a full-ride, four-year, undergraduate merit scholarship that may be used by recipients at any accredited college or university in the United States. Any current high school

junior who plans to enroll in college in the fall of 2018, and is an American citizen or legal permanent resident, is eligible to apply (unfortunately current high school seniors are not eligible to apply).

Coolidge Scholars are selected based on three main criteria:

- 1. Academic excellence
- 2. Interest in public policy and an understanding of the values President Coolidge championed:
- 3. Humility, service, and leadership


