Student Transportation

- Communicate in writing with your child's teacher if there are changes in how the student will travel to and from school each day.
- Permission to go home with another student requires a written note from each student's parent / guardian.
- We cannot change transportation based on the word of the student.

Phone calls and fax messages regarding transportation changes leave room for error. Therefore, your child's teacher must be notified in writing if there is a change in his/her transportation.

Each family is assigned a family number. Families will retain the same number if you had one assigned the previous year. New users will be issued a car tag at registration to hang on your rear view mirrors. This number will need to be in the car window whenever you or another authorized person will be picking up your child(ren). This is a security measure we have put into place at our school.

In cases of extreme emergency, a parent or guardian may call the office to change transportation. This must be done before 2:00 pm.
