



# What is expected of your 6<sup>th</sup> grade teacher?


- To have a love for children, teaching, and learning

### Procedures

- Students are tardy after 7:55 AM. Report to Main Office for entrance pass.
- After school pick-up begins at 3:10; no later than 3:30 PM.
- Early pick-up (Parent must sign students out from the Main Office)
