Cost: \$160

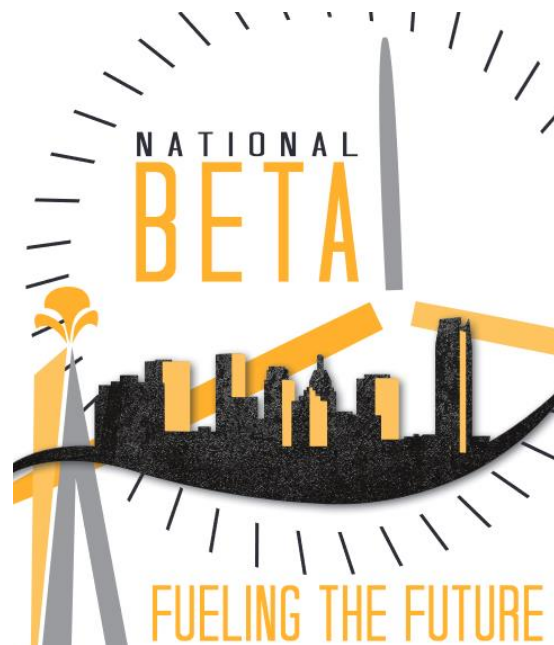
Payment plan:
