DRESS CODE FOR BACCALAUREATE AND COMMENCEMENT CEREMONIES

All students will wear their graduation cap and gowns for these two events.

Females: Church dress that complies with the school dress code; BLACK dress shoes (NO FLIP FLOPS); do not wear the white collar that comes with the robe

Males: Dark navy or black dress slacks (NO JEANS OR KHAKIS); white dress shirt; dark, navy, or black PLAIN tie; black dress shoes, dark socks (NO FLIP FLOPS OR TENNIS SHOES)

- No decorations of any kind will be allowed on caps or gowns.
- Only Newberry School District approved/issued cords and stoles may be worn.

DRESS CODE FOR SENIOR NIGHT

All students should dress nicely and follow the school dress code. Students who are out of dress code will be asked to change or leave.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS
