

### Community Invited to Pumpkin Drop

Mrs. Cotney's Physics Honors class have been working on their engineering designs to prepare for the Annual Pumpkin Drop occurring on November 1. Throughout this challenge, students will have used their Science and Engineering Practices to design, test, and calculate different variables to determine if their design is feasible in protecting their pumpkin. This project is in conjunction with the City of Newberry Fire Department, as they will be dropping the pumpkin apparatus from the bucket of the fire truck (about 60 feet in the air). After the pumpkin drop, students will put together a presentation including their design, calculations, and reflection upon their design.
