We need your help to reduce the spread of germs! By working together, taking precautions, we can help to minimize the impact of any illness that can be spread to others.

Please keep sick children at home for at least 24 hours after they no longer have vomiting or diarrhea or fever. They must be fever free without the use of fever-reducing medicines for 24 hours prior to coming to school.

So, if your child has been vomiting, had several episodes of diarrhea or fever to-day, they cannot come to school tomorrow. If they are sent home due to vomiting, diarrhea or fever, they cannot come to school the next day as they need to be symptom free for 24 hours.
