**School Improvement Council Meeting Notes**  
**Thursday, March 15, 2018**

Dr. Hampton started the meeting by welcoming and thanking each individual for attending and asking if there were any first time attendees to introduce themselves and their connection to Brookdale. As always, she challenged attendees to encourage another parent or community member to attend the next meeting. She opened the floor for suggestions on how we can increase the participation of parents/community members attending the monthly meetings.

Mrs. Nelson welcomed everyone and read the minutes from the February meeting.

Ms. Grant, Data Coach shared results from the Spring MAP assessment. Based on preliminary results, over 70% of the students made growth from the winter assessment. Ms. Grant shared the RIT Goals for each grade level/content area. The revised Intervention plan was shared with parents. The Intervention plan consisted of the skills covered, schedules of Interventionists, and the number of students per grade level. Attendees were very pleased with the results and commended the faculty and staff.

Mrs. Nelson shared the Need Assessment, reviewed the 2017-18 Title I plan, and the suggestions from the February Title I Team Planning meeting. An additional suggestion was shared to implement more morning parenting sessions. The suggestion was noted and will be included in the 1<sup>st</sup> draft of the 2018-19 Title I Plan.
