



## Orangeburg Consolidated School District Five Summer School 2017

**Guidelines:** All summer school courses are designed for those students who are recovering a course (Grade of 50-59-previously attempted) or for initial credit (<50 or never taken). **\*Initial credit WILL NOT be offered for English I, Algebra I, Biology or US History.** Only Orangeburg Consolidated 5 students who are currently enrolled for 2016-2017 will be allowed to attend the summer school program. Courses will be offered using Odysseyware in conjunction with a content teacher who will provide assistance and monitor student progress. It is very important that students manage their time effectively and efficiently. Classes offered on site, will be held from 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Monday - Thursday. Students will have the option of face-to-face contact or may elect to work from home (*technology will not be provided*). Students must earn at least 60% mastery on the assessments and self-regulation/self-discipline will be essential for success in completing courses. All course work must be completed by 1:00 p.m. June 23<sup>rd</sup> (for ½ credit courses or credit recovery) or by 1:00 p.m. July 13<sup>th</sup> (for 1 credit courses) - NO extensions or refund will be granted.

Credit Recovery \$100.00 (Assignment/Assessment) June 6 – June 15, 2017  
Failure Due to Attendance (FA) – June 5, 2017 – June 29, 2017 (*ON SITE ONLY*)  
(\$10.00 per number of days missed and serve 1 hour per number of days missed)

### **Process for Registration for Summer School:**

Step 1: Complete student and parent information on application.

Step 2: Submit application to counselor for course approval.

Step 3: Submit payment to bookkeeper (Gym Lobby)

\*All tuition must be paid in full on the first day of summer school. Fees are non-refundable.
