



Orangeburg Consolidated School District Five 2018 Summer School Overview

All summer school courses are designed for those students who are recovering a course (Grade of 50-59-previously attempted) or for initial credit (<50 or never taken). Orangeburg Consolidated 5 students who are currently enrolled for 2017-2018 will be allowed to attend the summer school program. All classes will be instructed through a blending learning approach utilizing the OCSD5 Virtual Learning System in conjunction with a content teacher who will provide assistance and monitor student progress. It is very important that students manage their time effectively and efficiently. Classes will be held from 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. Monday - Thursday. Self-regulation/self-discipline will be essential for success. Failure to abide by accepted standards of student conduct will result in student dismissal without a refund. Students must earn at least 60% mastery on the assessments. **All course work must be completed by 2:00 p.m. Monday, July 9, 2018 (for credit recovery) or by 2:00 p.m. Thursday, August 2, 2018 (Seniors attempting initial credit) - NO extensions will be granted.**

Cost: Administrative Fee - \$50.00 (per course) Students may earn up to two (2) credits.

Process for Registration for Summer School:

Step 1: Complete Summer School Application and submit completed application no later than Thursday, June 7, 2018.

Step 2: Report to the designated location on the first day of summer school on June 11, 2018 at 8:00 a.m.

Step 3: The bookkeeper will be set up in the area designated by the school to collect all appropriate fees.

Step 4: Please be on time Monday, June 11, 2018 with paper, pencil/pen and a notebook.

Payment: All tuition must be paid in full on the first day of summer school. Fees are non-refundable. ***Cash or money orders only please - No personal checks will be accepted.***

Registration: Monday, June 4 - Thursday, June 8, 2018. (All completed applications must be approved by the student's school counselor **PRIOR** to payment on the first day of summer school).
