Greetings Sheridan Elementary School Superstar Parents,

I hope everyone is in good health and that everyone is continuing to follow the safety procedures issued by the Center of Disease Control.

By now, your child/children should have received a packet with 10 days of class assignments. This work was either picked up from the school or delivered by the bus driver when lunch was brought to your area. These assignments will be graded and put into the gradebook for the fourth nine weeks. If your child receives an assignment that requires internet or device usage, and they do not have internet access or a device, the assignment will not count against them.

Completed assignments will need to include the student's first and last name, their grade level, and homeroom teacher's name on their completed and returned assignments. The first 5 days of assignments should be returned to the school site no later than Thursday March 26, 2020. Completed assignments can be returned to the school by parent drop-off between the hours of 7:45 a.m. and 2:45 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Teacher assistants will also be assigned to the busses to collect work on the following days: Monday, March 23, 2020 and Thursday March 26, 2020.

The second 5 days assignments should be turned in no later than Thursday April 2, 2020; again parents can drop off completed assignments, Monday through Friday from 7:45 a.m. until 2: 45 p.m. Teacher assistants will be on the bus on Monday, March 30, 2020 and Thursday April 2, 2020 to collect assignments as well.

Parents, we are asking that you limit the number of people you bring with you to pick up report cards and when you drop off/pick up assignments. The Center for Disease Control, along with the Governor of South Carolina is limiting gatherings/ groups of more than 10 people in one area. Please assist us with complying with the CDC guidelines to stay healthy and safe.

As we go through these times of uncertainty, it is important that our school, parents, and community work together to ensure our students are receiving a high quality education in a safe and healthy environment.

We will continue to update you through the district web page, voice callouts, and other media outlets as changes occur.
