CRITERIA FOR ALTRUSA SCHOLARSHIPS – 2012

I am applying for the Sarah Ketron Scholarship that is intended for women who are returning to school (re-entry) after interrupting their education for work, family obligations, etc.
I am applying for the general scholarship that is for women who are continuing their education, post-high school.
All applicants must provide the documentation and information requested below or the application will not be considered.
Scholarship monies will be given directly to the institution to be used for tuition, books and other academic fees.
 All applications must meet the following criteria: Must be typed or legibly written in black ink. Applications may be submitted via email to altrusaoakridgescholarship@gmail.com, or may be printed and mailed by post with other required documentation.
• Must show proof of admission to a post-high school educational institution (4 year, 2 year, technical, or vocational) and be enrolled in at least the minimum number of hours required by the institution, prior to the term of attendance.
 Must provide an official transcript from the academic institution most recently attended before the application deadline.
 Applicants chosen for consideration must be available for an interview by members of the Altrusa Scholarship Committee.
• Applicants who are awarded a scholarship must attend the Altrusa International Club of Oak Ridge meeting on Wednesday , May 23, 2012 at noon. Presentation of scholarships will be made at that time. (<i>Exceptions can be made if there are conflicts that cannot be avoided</i> .)
