Expectations

Campers should arrive on time and be ready to train by 9:00 a.m. Each camper should be willing to work hard, be polite to the other campers and the coaches, be receptive to coaching, and to be willing to have fun. Campers should arrive each day in soccer appropriate clothing (t-shirt, shorts). They should also have either cleats or athletic shoes as well as shin guards. In case of inclement weather, all campers should have athletic shoes that would be appropriate for the gym floor (tennis or basketball shoes). Campers should eat a good breakfast and also bring a snack and enough water to last them throughout the day.

Location

Future Viking Soccer camp will be held at the Soccer Practice Fields (old Central Elementary School) beside Vance Middle School. However, if we are experiencing bad weather on any days then the camp will be relocated to the Stone Castle or Viking Hall adjacent to THS.

Schedule

Camp will begin with a warm-up and stretching exercises. Campers will then be broken up into age/skill specific groups. Instruction for the younger campers will focus on basic skills and technique. Instruction for older campers will focus on basic skills and also position play. At each days end, we will have small sided scrimmages to allow the campers to try to implement those skills they learned into game situations. Water breaks will be given as often as needed to keep the campers hydrated.

Coaching Staff

The Viking soccer campers will receive instruction from the members of the Tennessee High coaching staff. Current and former Lady Viking players will also be instructing the campers.

Cost

Camp will cost \$45 if the camper is registered by June 23rd. If the camper registers after the date, the camp will cost \$50. Each camper will receive a camp t-shirt and a picture with her coach.
