

Graduation Expectations 2017

Students who participate in the graduation ceremony at Tennessee High School are expected to abide by the following behavior guidelines:

Any behavior that detracts from the solemnity of the ceremony will not be tolerated. Objects such as beach balls or other balls, silly string, sound making devices, noisemakers, projectiles, etc., found to be in the possession of the graduation participant before or during the ceremony will be considered as a violation.

Air horns or other sound making devices detract from the full recognition of all the graduates; therefore, neither the audience nor the graduates will be permitted to have these kinds of devices in their possession during the ceremony.

Only THS cords / sashes will be allowed (Valedictorian, TN Scholar, NHS, and Medal for Highest Distinction.)

Students who violate the graduation behavior guidelines will be subject to the jurisdiction of **School Board Policy #7.132**.

School Board Policy #7.132

Any student found to be in violation of the Behavior Agreement will have his/ her diploma and final transcript withheld pending discipline and a conference with the Director of Schools.

Behavior Agreement

I understand and agree for my child to abide by the Behavior Agreement. I also acknowledge the repercussions that will follow any breach of this agreement.

This Behavior Agreement must be returned to the principal no later than Monday, May 1, 2017.
