The benchmark assessments, which are aligned to College- and Career-Ready Standards/Common Core State Standards (CCSS), & TNReady, provide valuable data regarding all students' knowledge of the standards. RTI Aimsweb Testing	August 14 - 16, 2019 December 11 - 13, 2019 May 7- 9, 2020	Diagnostic assessment used to help determine skill deficit areas and support intervention plans within Response to Instruction and Intervention (RTI2)	Required	The results are used in RTI2 TEAM meetings to determine student placements.
TCAP Testing	April 13 – May 8, 2020	The Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program addresses the Tennessee state standards, and is intended to provide information regarding student achievement to educators, parents, and the public. TCAP is used to determine the level at which students meet content standards and to measure progress over time at the school and district levels. Students in grades 3-8 will be assessed in the spring in all content areas. The student score from TCAP will be calculated into the student's class average. The score on the TCAP will be 15% of the overall grade.	Required	Fall 2020
NAEP Testing - 8th Grade (Math & Reading)	TBA	NAEP is a common measure of student achievement across the country and is used to inform education policies and practices.	Required of 50 Randomly Selected Students	Results are reported collectively as a state.
MAP Testing (6th/7th)	Fall 2019 / Spring 2020	MAP data shows student academic growth on a nationally-normed test.	Required	3 Weeks
