

Graduation Requirements – *Beginning with the Class of 2019*

Below are the minimum **23 credits** required for high school graduation

English 4 credits I, II, III, & IV

Mathematics 4 credits (Students must be enrolled in a math class every year of high school)

- 1 credit of Algebra I
- 1 credit of Geometry
- 1 credit of Algebra II
- 1 credit of an upper level math

Science 3 credits

- 1 credit of a lab science (Physical World Concepts, Physical Sci., Anatomy & Physiology, Environmental Sci., **or** Agriscience)
- 1 credit of Biology
- 1 credit of Chemistry or Physics

Social Studies 3 credits

- 1 credit of World Geography, World History, or AP Human Geography
- 1 credit of US History
- ½ credit of Economics **or** Business Economics, **or** one (1) credit of Marketing Education I
- ½ credit of ****** U.S. Government **or** American Bus. Legal Systems

Wellness* 1 credit (½ credit of Health **AND** ½ credit of either P.E. or Physical Training)

* Two (2) credits of JROTC will replace (1) credit of Wellness requirement

Physical Activity ½ credit** (½ credit of either P.E., Physical Training, S1 of Band, or Band Aux.)

Personal Finance ½ credit**

Foreign Language 2 credits (Levels I and II of the **same language**)

Fine Arts 1 credit (Visual Arts, Theater, Choir, Band/Band Aux., General Music, AP Music Theory)

Program of Study 3 credits (all 3 credits must be attained from the **same Program of Study**)

Elective 1 credit

ACT or SAT (must take)

Civics Test (must pass)

Three (3) credits of JROTC will replace ½ credit for Physical Activity, ½ credit of Personal Finance, **and ½ credit US Government requirements.

SENIOR TOP TEN PERCENT: To qualify for the Top 10% of the senior class, students must pass at **least one** (1) honors course **OR** one (1) AP course in **each of the core academic areas**; Math, English, Social Studies & Science.
