

Seniors:

Please stop by the counseling office and check to make sure your name is on the Top Rank, Honors, and Distinction Lists located on the table in the counseling lobby. You may also sign-up on the clipboard on the table to receive a copy of your transcript. We encourage students to double-check their transcripts.

### **Top Rank**

- To be considered for Top Rank, students must earn a total of 10 honors, AP, or dual enrollment classes **AND**
- Have at least a 21 ACT composite score. Students must meet the 21 ACT composite requirement no later than the December of senior year ACT because DCHS ranks in early February.

### **Distinction**

DCHS will recognize students on awards day as graduating with distinction if they have or are working on:

1. Earned a nationally recognized industry certification
2. Participated in at least one of the Governor's Schools
3. Participated in one of the state's All State Musical Organizations.
4. Been selected as a National Merit Finalist or Semi-Finalist
5. Attained a composite score of 31 or higher on the ACT
6. Attained a score of 3 or higher on at least two Advanced Placement (AP) exams.
7. Earned 12 or more semester hours of postsecondary (dual enrollment credit).

### **Honors**

DCHS will recognize students on awards day as graduating with honors if they have met all ACT College Readiness Benchmarks

- English - 18
- Reading - 22
- Math - 22
- Science - 23
