Seniors: We hope you have begun thinking about your educational plans after graduation. We want to let you know that October 1, is the time to fill out your Free Application of Federal Student Aid. Submitting the FAFSA form will give you valuable information about the financial aid and grants. It also serves as the application for the Hope (Lottery) Scholarship and the Wilder-Naifeh Technical Skills Grant which helps those who would like financial support to attend a Tennessee College of Applied Technology Center.

Your FAFSA needs to be submitted regardless of the type of Post-Secondary education you are pursuing. We are striving for a goal of 100% participation from our senior class. You can find the form at www.fafsa.gov. It is a FREE application. We are here to help you fill out the form if you need us. If you have any questions, please call or come by the counseling office.

Remember to apply for you and your parents' Federal Student Aid ID to complete your FAFSA online at www.fsaaid.ed.gov. You must have these numbers at least 3 days prior to completing your FAFSA. Apply for FAFSA after October 1st. You may use your parent's prior year's tax return. To receive priority for many financial programs, apply before March 1st. If you need help in completing your FAFSA, come to the guidance office.

If YOU do not apply for a scholarship, YOU will not receive one!

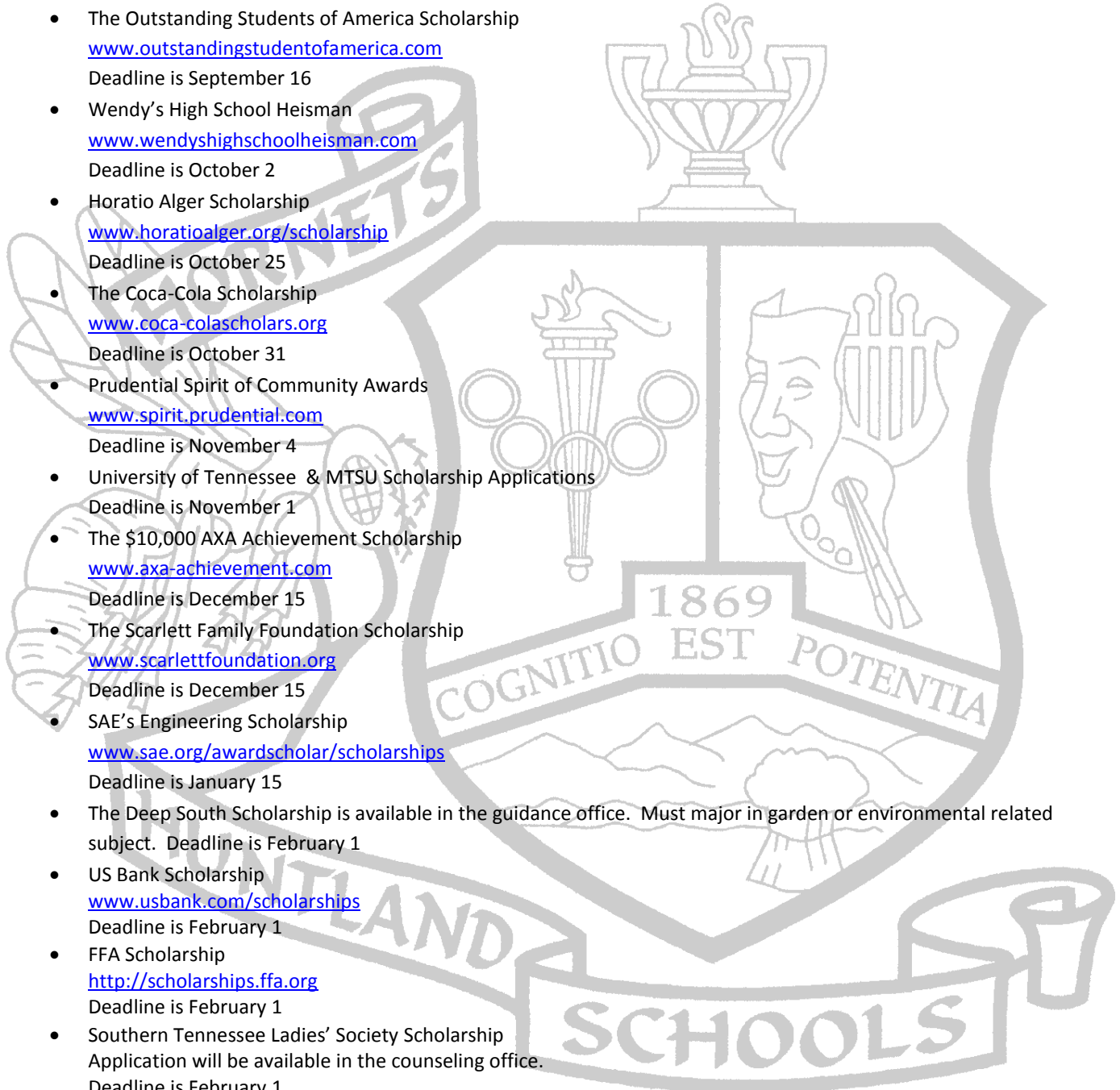
Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship Program:

All students must submit Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) after Oct. 1st, at www.fafsa.ed.gov. In addition, apply for your FSA ID at www.fsaaid.ed.gov.

- **TENNESSEE PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP** FREE TUITION FOR 2 YEARS AT A 2 YEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR TCAT Apply at www.tnpromise.gov
- **HOPE SCHOLARSHIP:** 21ACT/980 SAT or 3.0 GPA \$3500 for 4 year institutions for the first 2 years and \$4500 for the last 2 years — \$3000 for 2 year institutions per year
- **ASPIRE AWARD:** 21ACT/980 SAT or 3.0 GPA Adjusted Gross Income of \$36,000 or less \$250 per semester supplemental
- **GENERAL ASSEMBLY MERIT SCHOLARSHIP** Must be HOPE SCHOLARSHIP eligible 29 ACT/1280 SAT and 3.75 GPA \$500 per semester
