At John Hay Elementary, our students and their families are the top priority. We encourage you to feel free to contact your child's teacher or the office if you find your family in crisis or need. We will gladly assist you in any way possible. We consider all of you to be a part of our John Hay Family, and we hope you have a wonderful school year.

John Hay/HCBOE Services

The following services are available to qualifying students at the school level. Applications and/or referral information can be obtained through the school office.

Free/Reduced Breakfast and lunch served at school. Acceptance based on family income.

Extended School Program provides after-school care for John Hay students. Nominal fees apply.

After-school tutoring is available to students needing extra help with schoolwork.

Individual counseling is available on a limited basis through our John Hay Guidance Counselor. Students seeking guidance from the counselor should contact their teacher or the school office.

Homeless students can receive school supplies and other services. This includes, but is not limited to, students living in hotels, shelters, cars, or "doubled up" with another family.

HCBOE Department of Special Education provides many services to qualifying students ages 3-21 living in Hamblen County. Children must meet requirements as determined by a Screening Team. Related services may include speech, language, physical/occupational therapy, and/or individual counseling.

HCBOE Hispanic Community Liaison—Juan Cervantes is available to assist our Spanish speaking families. The office can put you in touch with Mr. Cervantes as needed.

Food on Foot provides take-home meals for eligible students during weekend and school breaks.
