Prom Dress Code in Handbook

Inappropriate Attire for Ladies:

- 1. Gowns that have a split from the hem to above mid-thigh.
- 2. Neck lines that plunge below breasts or that are too revealing.
 - 3. Backs of dresses that fall below the waistline.
- 4. Anything that is see-through or too revealing of body parts that should not be visible.
 - 5. Dresses above mid-thigh.
- 6. The top band of the skirt or pants must be within one half inch (1/2) of the navel (belly button) all the way around the waist. The band of the skirt/pants must be straight and not have cut outs or scallops that go below the one half inch (1/2) requirement from the navel.

Men's Attire:

- 1. Men must wear a tux or a suit with a tie, dress shirt, dress pants, dress shirt and jacket.
 - 2. NO JEANS of any color.
 - 3. NO Chains
 - **4**. Shirt must remain on the entire night.
- 5. The men's **GUEST** <u>must adhere</u> to the above ladies' guidelines even though she may not be a student of MHHSE.
