Kindergarten

- \_\_\_\_\_ Backpack – (no wheels) This should be large enough to hold your child’s folders, library books, jacket, etc.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 durable folders- with **3 holes** to go in binder (**5 star holds up best**)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1” 3 ring binder with a **clear plastic front/back covering**
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 **clear** zipper pencil pouch for a 3 ring binder
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 packs of 12 glue sticks, or more
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12- #2 **plain** pencils (**no designs**) \*\*\* (Ticonderoga lasts longer)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 bottle of **Elmer’s** school glue (no gels)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 pair of **Fiskars** scissors (teacher tested to last longer and more reliable)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3 boxes of **Crayola** crayons (only) 16-24 count \*\*\*
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 plastic pencil box – cigar box size – nothing bigger/smaller
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4 composition books (**usually black and white**) (**no wire bound**)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4 big pink erasers
- \_\_\_\_\_ Highlighters (pack of 4)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 set of **headphones** in a Ziploc bag with child’s name (**NO EARBUDS**)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2 primary journals (There will be space at the top for drawing and space at the bottom for writing. The lines at the bottom for writing will have, a solid line (top), dotted line (middle), and solid line (bottom), for them to learn to form letters correctly.) (Journal will say K-2)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1 change of clothing – In the event of any accident at school, a seasonal change of clothing is need to be left in your child’s backpack with name on the inside labels.
