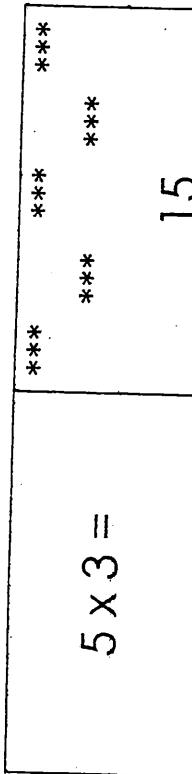

## 4th Grade Summer Math Project

Welcome to the Fourth Grade at Barger Academy of Fine Arts! We, the 4th grade teachers, are looking forward to fun and engaging math activities next school year. To be ready for these, however, you need to KNOW the multiplication facts from 0 x 0 to 10 x 10.

Your project this summer is to create your own multiplication flash cards, and to **memorize** the facts.

- Buy a package of index cards. On the front of an index card, write out one multiplication equation. On the backside, write the answer to that equation. You may also find it helpful to draw a simple illustration, as shown below, to help you visualize the fact as well. Remember, it is **not enough** to be able to count and figure out the answer.



- By the time school starts in August, you need to **know** the answer to all of these facts. You should be able to say the answer as fast as you can tell someone your age when they ask you.

- When you return to school in the fall, you need to bring your flashcards to show your teacher and be ready to take a timed multiplication test on all of these facts.

Here are some other ideas you can try to help make it fun while you're memorizing:

\*Sequence count by the number whose facts you're memorizing while bouncing a ball, jumping rope, or doing anything rhythmic and active. For example, if you're memorizing the sixes, you would say: 6, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42, 48, 54, 60 over and over while doing the activity.

\*Write the facts using sidewalk chalk, window markers, or bathtub paint.

\*Turn it into a game by rolling 2 dice or turning over 2 playing cards and multiplying the 2 numbers that come up. (Using the cards 2 - 10.) The player with the highest product wins that hand or gets a point. The winner is the one who has the most points when you're finished. (You decide how many rounds or how long you want to play.)
