	EXIT PROCEDURE

- Because a crucial component of our mission is to provide a democratic opportunity for all children to succeed, it is the obligation of each student, with the support of parents, to make the most of his or her capabilities while attending CSAS or CSLA. Therefore, it is understood that after appropriate interventions have been attempted without success, it may be recommended that a child be withdrawn from CSAS or CSLA if the following circumstances occur:
- Student's behavior is disruptive in the school setting to the extent that is not only interferes with his/her learning, but also indicates a lack of self-discipline or respect for others.
- Student's academic experiences and growth do not reflect commitment or self-motivation toward the learning process. This includes, but is not limited to, honoring academic and/or social support contracts.
- Parent support and involvement are not adequate to insure the child's academic and behavioral success at CSAS and CSLA (This is in addition to eighteen (18) volunteer hours and two parent conferences.)
