## PTA News

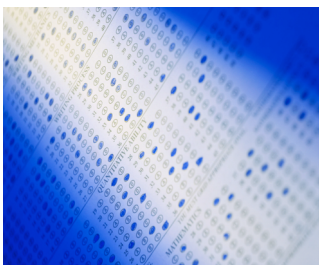

## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade News



The **EXPLORE** test will be coming up for all eighth graders on October 21<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>th</sup>. This test is the eighth grade version of the **ACT** test, which is given in the junior year of high school. The results of the **ACT** test often determine students' acceptance into college as well as their eligibility for the **HOPE** scholarship. Therefore, it is extremely important for your children to take this test seriously and to do their best. The scores they receive on the **EXPLORE** test are a very good predictor of how well they will perform when they take the actual **ACT** test.
