

# HELPING YOUR CHILD AT HOME

We are all working towards the same goal- helping your child reach his/her academic potential! Some children need extra academic support (one-on-one) to reach his/her academic potential. Homework will be given on Mondays and not due until the next Monday. I do this so if you need the weekend to complete any of it, you have it.

**READING:** I will send home a leveled reading book for your child to read each day. It will be located in your child's blue communication folder in the clear plastic sleeve labeled "Read Every Day". There is an information sheet in the folder further explaining this.

**WRITING:** Please check your child's writing by making sure his/her sentences have the following:

- Capital letter at the beginning of each sentence
- Spaces between the words
- It makes sense
- It ends with the correct punctuation

**SIGHT WORDS:** Please practice the weekly sight words with your child. I will assess your child on them and mark it on the Sight Word Checklist in the blue communication folder. Please check to see what words your child needs to study. They will be highlighted. I would suggest getting some magnetic letters and a white board with a dry erase marker to practice the sight words.

**MATH:** Your child's math homework will be a review of a skill already taught. Please practice addition and subtraction facts each day. I would suggest getting some flash cards from the Dollar Tree. Also, it is never too early to teach identifying coins, dollar bills, and time!
