SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority is a sisterhood that focuses on public service. Our organization was founded in Washington, D.C. in 1913 on the campus of Howard University by twenty-two collegiate women. Since its inception, Delta has encouraged students to seek postsecondary education. Because of this founding principle, the members of the Chattanooga Alumnae Chapter award scholarships to outstanding African American *female* seniors in Hamilton County.

Each *female* scholarship applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Reside in our service area which is Hamilton County;
- Possess a 3.0 or higher grade point average by the end of the first semester of her senior year;
- Submit the online scholarship application at the following link

- Provide a letter of recommendation from a school official to include your participation in community service activities;
- Provide a copy of the official acceptance letter from a college or university;
- Submit an essay about your aspirations and goals (*250 words or less with the standard one inch margin and Times New Roman 12 font*);
- Include an official copy of your transcript which is sealed and by the school registrar; and
- Consent to a face-to-face interview.

The deadline for your completed scholarship packet is February 14, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. Packets received after the deadline will not be considered.
