LUPTON SCHOLARSHIP FUND AT WELLESLEY COLLEGE - each year a small number of students from the Chattanooga area who are admitted to Wellesley and are eligible for financial aid are designated as Lupton Scholars. These students receive scholarships, as well as summer internship stipends and may be eligible for loan forgiveness if they choose to return to Chatt. following graduation from Wellesley. Application fee is waived for students who apply online using the common application. See Mrs. Richard if interested.

THAT IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR MTSU, UTK, TN TECH FOR SCHOLARSHIP PURPOSES BUT SHOULD BE DONE FOR ALL SCHOOLS.

CHATTANOOGA STATE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

New this year – you must first be accepted to Chatt State and have you're a number – this is up and running for DE students and should be up for all students by Dec 10 -

www.chattanoogastate.edu There are 3 scholarships available on the 1 application. Deadline is Feb 23rd Click on Scholarships under “student” on the bottom of the home page or log into TigerWeb and click on “Apply for Scholarships” in the financial aid section

Chattanooga State Scholarship Priority Deadline – February 23rd – You must complete the college application, scholarship application, your FAFSA (fafsa.gov) by this date – You do NOT have to upload your transcript – I will take care of that part

Chatt State Academic Service Scholarship – Must have a 2.9 GPA

Chatt State Foundation Scholarship – many various scholarships 16+ ACT are invited to apply as well as those with lower GPA's

Chatt State ACT scholarship – 23+ACT – Must fill out the Foundation Scholarship application

Chatt State Empowerment Grant – for 1st generation college (neither parent has a bachelor's degree), economically disadvantaged, minority

TN PTSA TEACHING SCHOLARSHIP – for students planning on a career in education

The Tennessee PTA Scholarship is for any students interested in a teaching or child related career

and either you or your parent(s) are members of a PTA. \$2000 The deadline is March 1st.

Tennessee Tech University Scholarships – Once you have applied for admission to TN Tech, you can apply for scholarships online. **Just one application allows you to compete for over 450 scholarships offered by TTU.** Go to www.tntech.edu/scholarships now through **December 15, 2013** for more information and to apply.

Last Day to apply to UTK is Dec 15th. Everything must be in – transcript, money, ACT, application.

GATES MILLENIUM SCHOLARS- this scholarship will pay ALL expenses at ANY college in the US and will also pay for GRADUATE studies in 5 areas – To be eligible you must: 1. Be African American, American Indian/Alaskan native, Asian Pacific Islander American or Hispanic 2. Have a GPA of 3.3 unweighted 3. Have demonstrated leadership abilities through various extracurricular activities 4. Be Federal Pell Grant eligible – Forms may **be submitted electronically at www.gmsp.org (recommended) Deadline for submission is January 15th – ALL 3 FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THIS DATE!**

The 2014 **GMS Online Application** is Open! Applicants and references (nominators & recommenders) must **register** for an online account before logging in to access and complete the forms. Applicants can copy and paste the URL of the account registration page and provide it with their nine-digit Registration ID# to e-mail an invitation to their nominator and recommender. All three forms will be linked together to complete a GMS application package using the applicant's Registration ID#, first and last names. The **deadline is Wednesday, January 15, 2014 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time (EST).**
