- Committee Updates

Tara reported the total bring home from the Silent Auction was \$6496!!! This was 69% of value of items offered in the auction. There were 46 items offered and only one with no bids. Tara sent business to the owner of the auction item (the item needed to be used prior to the end of 2017) and hopefully business will return for next year's Auction.

Tara also reported she noticed more bidders on each item than those at the Jubilee. Noted that the braces item resulted in \$4250. Will alternate with other dentists for Silent Auction next and future years.

There was a \$195 dollars of fees not subtracted from total reported from Allison Deckman. It was also noted that there were many bidders that did not pay that night but everyone paid after follow up calls. The thought was that many of the early student presenter families left before the end of auction. There was also \$600 of donations in general not associated with a Silent Auction item from that night.
