Scratches only need to be fixed if the scratches distort iPad images or change the effectiveness of the iPad. If the student has lost the iPad, there will be a \$225 fee to get a replacement. Hamilton County Schools has decided to use these iPads in special education settings for next year to support elementary students. We look forward to providing the devices for this endeavor.
