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RE: Discipline Procedures

The purpose of a school wide discipline plan is to remediate behavior and address issues that limit the ability of the teacher to instruct his/her class in an effective manner. Any discipline procedure that we have is corrective in nature. In the event that unacceptable behavior is observed, we desire to use it as a lesson to help students understand how best to conduct themselves.

We will be using Class Dojo for our classroom management and record keeping system. There are options to set up buttons on the program that represent positive behaviors and behaviors that need to be addressed. The positive behaviors can be chosen and edited by each classroom teacher as he or she sees fit. However, the “needs work” behaviors shall have, at a minimum, the following options:

1. Be respectful
2. Be prepared
3. Keep hands, feet, and other objects to yourself

Below are the point values with consequences:

1. Loss of 1 point serves as a warning.
2. Loss of 2-3 points in one day is a loss of playtime in 5 minute increments.
3. Loss of 4 points in one day is a loss of all playtime and conference with the principal.
4. Loss of 5 points in one day would result in an office referral.
5. A loss of 9 points in a week will result in an office visit.
6. Loss of 10 points in one week will result in an office referral.

Teachers should make a reasonable effort to communicate with parents through a variety of methods, except for Facebook, Twitter, and other social media outlets.
