

Important ACT information for 11th graders

- All students arrive at school no later than 8:00 a.m. No students will be admitted to a test room after the test has begun.
- Room assignments for testing will be posted in the commons beginning March 12, 2018.
- You will be admitted into your assigned test room, one at a time, and you must show your student ID/photo ID before you can be admitted. Once admitted, you will be assigned a seat.
- Eating and/or drinking are not permitted in the test room—do not bring food items.
- You may not have a timer, cell phone, media player, or electronic device of any kind in the test room. **If it is discovered that you have a cell phone, smart watch, media player, or other electronic device in the test room, or you use one during break, you will be dismissed and your answer folder will not be scored.**
- ACT permits examinees to use a calculator on the mathematics test. A TI84 will be provided by JCHS, if the student does not bring their own.
- If you are dismissed during the test for any reason, your answer folder will not be scored and you will have to pay to take the test at a later date. Also, if you are dismissed during the test, you will be escorted to ISS and will not be dismissed until 3:20 p.m.
- The test is 3 hours long and you will be permitted to leave school at the conclusion of testing with parent permission. All plans for leaving must be made in advance. A parking tag will not be required on this date. Breakfast and lunch will be available on test day.
- Breakfast will be available to all testing students on March 20, 2018.
- **ACT is a TN Department of Education Graduation Requirement.**
