Seniors – The clock is ticking! Submit your FAFSA now at www.fafsa.ed.gov or download the new mystudentaid app and submit your FAFSA directly from your phone. FAFSA is the application for Federal and State aid, including the Federal Pell Grant and the Hope Scholarship. Students must complete the FAFSA by February 1, 2019 to remain eligible for the Tennessee Promise Scholarship.

#### Need help with the FAFSA?

JCHS will be hosting a FAFSA Workshop on Tuesday, December 11th, from 4-7 P.M. Come out and complete the FAFSA and stay for a home basketball game as the Patriots take on Cocke County.
