Work-Based Learning: Career Practicum Course #6105

Work-Based Learning: Career Practicum is a capstone course intended to provide students with opportunities to apply the skills and knowledge learned in previous CTE and general education courses within a professional work environment. The course allows students to earn high school credit for select models of work-based learning, which allow students to interact with industry professionals in order to extend and deepen classroom work and support the development of postsecondary and career readiness knowledge and skills.

- Safety training: All students enrolled in work-based learning must complete safety training and master a safety test with 100% accuracy. No student will be allowed to perform any job declared hazardous by the state of Tennessee for minors while enrolled in WBL/Co-op.
- 2. <u>Driver License</u>: Students must provide proof of their age. Copies must be kept with the required WBL/Co-op documents by the WBL/Co-op Coordinator.
- 3. <u>Personalized Learning Plan</u>: All students enrolled in work-based learning must complete, during the school year, a personalized learning plan or portfolio. Students will complete these personalized learning plans as part of their WBL/Co-op grade.
- Required Documents: All students enrolled in the WBL/Co-op program must have on file with the WBL/Co-op Coordinator and with their employer copies of the following documents.
 - A. Work-based Learning Agreement
 - B. Work-based Learning Insurance and Emergency Agreement
 - C. Work-based Learning Safety Training Log
- 5. <u>Credits</u>: Students with 1 hour of WBL/Co-op (Seventh period) must average working 5 days/week during the school day.
- 6. <u>Attendance</u>: Students must maintain 90% attendance at school to participate in WBL/Co-op. This means you cannot be absent more than 9 days during either semester to participate in WBL/Co-op.
- 7. Grading: WBL/Co-op grades will be averaged from the following.

Α.	Weekly wage, hours, and journal reflections	40%
B.	Personalized Learning Plan	40%
C.	Employer evaluation	10%
D.	Attitude/participation	10%
