The McMinn County High School Sports Hall of Fame Committee is an organization established to honor outstanding sports figures. Each year the Committee will select new members to join the Hall of Fame. The public is encouraged to submit names of candidates for consideration. Those elected to the McMinn County High School Hall of Fame will be honored and their picture will be added to the **MCHS SPORTS HALL OF FAME** wall.

The established criterion for selection to the Hall of Fame is:

- The candidate should be an outstanding contributor to MCHS athletics, whether it is as a participant, coach, official, administrator, promoter or a person otherwise involved.
- The candidate should be of good moral character.
- The candidate does not have to be a resident of McMinn County at the time of nomination.
- The candidate notoriety of success must have been accomplished at McMinn County High School, with a degree of consideration given to accomplishments afterward.
- Candidates may be nominated and elected posthumously.
- In case of the athletic, he/she must have graduated from McMinn County High School for at least 10 years.
