The state of Tennessee has joined 46 states across the nation in adopting the Common Core standards. These standards guide teaching for English Language Arts and Math, K-12. The transition to these standards and the transition to new forms of assessments to ensure students learning will be a process that will not be fully complete until the 2014-2015 school year. The biggest change in curriculum implementations focuses on decreasing the number of standards covered to allow deeper understanding and mastery of skills.
