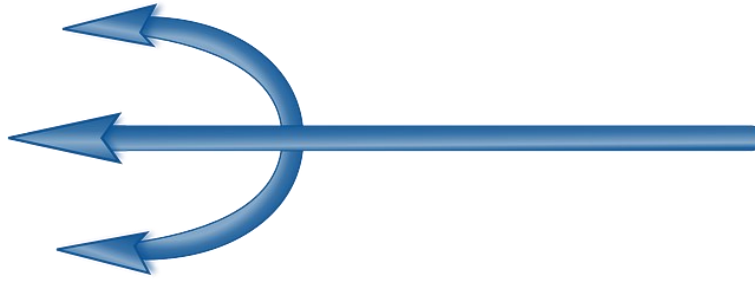


Patriot's Pen Essay Winners
