

DETENTION 2014-2015

1. Afterschool will be from 330-430. Before school will be determined to equal the amount to be served. Lunch detention is also used.
2. Students who are late will not be admitted and that day will not count. Also, late students will have time added to next assigned date.
3. Failure to serve detention will result in student choosing ISS at Midtown
4. Detention will be silent. No talking, no sleeping, no cell phones, homework, no reading. Books, cell phones, etc. will be taken up and the beginning and returned at the end of the detention day. Violation will result in the student being removed and the time will not count
5. Detention supervisor has the right at his/her discretion to give work, etc. to make detention an unpleasant experience.

CELL PHONE POLICY 2014-2015

The new rule for personal communication and /or personal electronic devices allows specific time and place uses of the item(s) (see policy on roaneschools.com). However, once in class devices need to be off.

1. First offense. Parent or guardian may pick phone up at the end of the school day. The student will bring the phone to the office for the next 3 days. The phone will remain in the office from 820-320. Student will be able to pick the phone up in the office at the end of the school day.
2. Second, third, etc. offenses will be handled according to the school board policy (read the policy)


\*Also, you may want to check your child's phone for inappropriate items (text messages, photos, etc.) to avoid any potential issues. You may also want to see what your child posts on social media.
