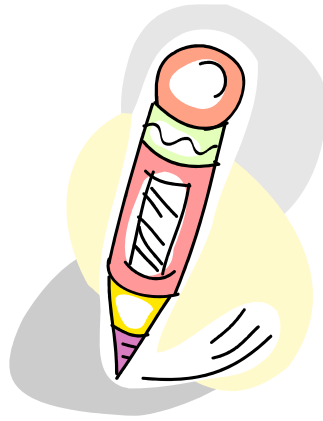


Calculate Your GPA



1) Obtain your most current transcript.

2) Assign a value to every grade using the following scale.

A= 4 points

B= 3 points

C= 2 points

D= 1 point

Classes you attempt but do not pass are assigned a zero and count as a credit attempted.

3) Multiply each point assignment by the amount of credit each course earns to calculate the quality points earned for each class.

For example:

Course	Grade	Credits	Point Assign	x	Credits=	Quality Points
Eng 11	92	1.0	3	X	1	= 3
US Hist	96	1.0	4	X	1	= 4
US Govt	97	.5	4	X	.5	= 2
Economics	82	.5	2	X	.5	= 1
Alg 2	78	1.0	2	X	1	= 2
Art 1	98	1.0	4	X	1	= 4
Physics	69	0.0	0	x	0	= 0
Nutri/Foods	88	1.0	3	x	1	= 3
Spanish 1	83	1.0	2	x	1	= 2
Total Quality Points						21

4) Divide the number of quality points by the number of credits attempted.

Quality points/Credits attempted= GPA

Example: $21/8 = 2.625$

Sample GPA is 2.625

Notes: Credit recovery grades count as credit earned but not as class credit attempted and is not included in the GPA calculations.
