Matisse Inspired Flower Drawing and Painting

Directions; A representative from each table will choose a vase of flowers their table group will be drawing. Once the upside-down drawing is completed, students will immediately draw the vase of flowers in pencil only. The flowers should be drawn in 3 dimensional viewpoint and fill the page or paper given. The drawing will take most of the period to finish. Details and textures are a must!

Once the flowers and vase are completed and checked by the teacher they will be outlined using a black sharpie marker.

Students will then view several slides of examples of Henri Matisse, a French Impressionistic painter. We will focus on Matisse' use of patterns and textures to decorate the background, like a wallpaper. Students will practice drawing several sketches of patterns that they could use as the wall paper behind their vase of flowers drawing. Once they choose their favorite patterns, the teacher is consulted and the patterns are carefully added to the background behind the vase of flowers. Draw in pencil and then go over pencil lines with the black sharpie marker. A table or surface like table is added to ground the vase. This is done before the wallpaper is added.

After the Vase of Flowers and wallpaper designs are completed, Students will practice watercolor pencil techniques shown to them by the teacher. The student then applies these techniques to coloring their vase of flowers. Students are instructed to use a limited pallet of colors.
