Class Parties & Assembly

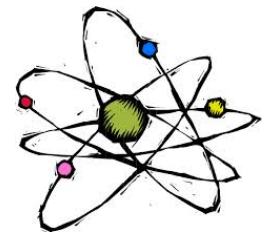
